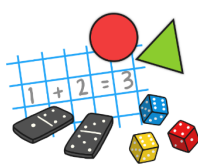

Our School Day:

The school day starts at 8:45am, finishes at 3:15pm. Children have a one-hour break for dinner. We believe that children learn best through play and real-life experiences. Children will spend most of their day choosing how they learn, based on their interests and own ideas and will have access to the indoor and outdoor areas throughout the whole day.



Everyday children will take part in a 15-20 minute whole-class teaching session for Phonics and Maths. In Phonics, we follow the 'Little Wandle' Letters and Sounds Revised Programme. Every child will have a reading book and a sharing book to take home and read with you. Children will also have a Talk for Writing, RE, PSHE, Art, PE, Music, or Topic input.



ClassDojo:

Parental Engagement is important so to include you as families in everyday learning and experiences we use 'ClassDojo'. Children can earn points for good behaviour and each week the child with the most dojo points will receive the ClassDojo Champion certificate during our whole school and team assemblies.



Assessment:

Children will be assessed using milestones of typical development for their age. When assessing, staff will consider and are fully aware that not all children follow 'typical' development. OPAL allows us to tell and celebrate each child's story and successes then focus on the support they need in school. It is also a way for you as families to be a part of your child's learning journey.
