



# Guide to Remote Learning

## January 2021

During this lockdown, there is an expectation that children's education continues at home as best as possible to avoid them falling further behind. Staff will be conducting live lessons each day using Zoom and Dojo.

Recent guidance stipulates it is a requirement that any pupil not in school engages with these lessons. A register will be taken each day to monitor attendance and pupils not present will be contacted as normal.

### Time Table

**Each year group will have two Zoom sessions a day – you must log in to both of them!**

KS1 + Y5/6	08:45 – 09:15
	10:30 – 11:00
FS2 + Y3/4	09:15 – 09:45
	11:00 – 11:30

Each day staff will provide input and resources for an English, Maths and Topic lesson. Following the Zoom input, pupils will have time to complete the tasks set.

The input will be an opportunity for you or your child to ask any questions you may have about the work set and reflect on the previous day.

Staff will be available during the day for support if required.

Resources packs will be prepared for your child to work in.

### Zoom

You might need to download the free app or software prior to using Zoom.

Teachers will send links out using Dojo. There is an expectation that pupils' behave in a mature manner whilst online and do not say, write or do anything to cause distress to others.

Please, where possible, find a workspace free of distractions and interruptions whilst lessons are taking place. Although school uniform is not required by those working at home, please dress appropriately for doing school work!

- Messages, links to web based resources and worksheets will be sent out using Class Dojo.
- Please take photos of your work and upload them on to your portfolio for teachers to provide feedback and plan subsequent lessons.
