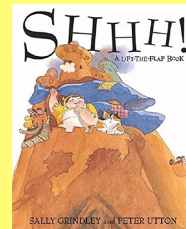
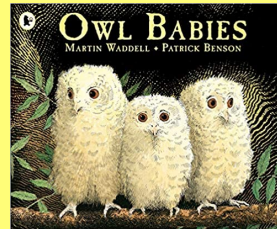
- ♥ Matching: To be able to identify similarities and differences across a range of criteria, for example by colour, shape, size, texture and function.

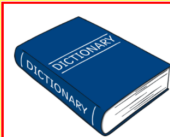
