Class Dojo

Zoom sessions:

- ⇒ There are two inputs each day from your class teacher. One for English and one for Maths. Teachers are modelling and talking about what is expected in order for you to go away and work independently.
- ⇒ Once work has been completed please add your work to the class dojo portfolio so that feedback an be given.
- ⇒ If you have any questions during the day you can contact the class teacher by dojo. They will get back to you at some point in the day but it may not be immediately as they are still teaching children in school. School finishes at 3.00pm.
- ⇒ If you haven't already done so, ask your teacher for your login (this could be a QR code or a pin number), select your name and share your work with your class teacher. This will only be seen by the class teacher.
- ⇒ When logging in, please be on time. Could you please log your child's name and ensure your camera is on, this helps staff when completing the register.
- ⇒ Please remember to mute microphones unless talking to the teacher to reduce the amount of background noise when sessions are being delivered.


Step 1: Scan your class QR Code
