


Maps Project Sheet - Year 5



Geography

Challenge #1

Find a map from your favourite film, book, TV show or video game. Using your knowledge of compass points (North, East, South, West) write the locations of at least 5 places from the map (eg. the village might be in the North-East).

Challenge #2

Create your own fantasy town and draw a map for it. Include physical features such as mountains and lakes, and human features like roads and schools. Make sure you clearly label the names of the places.

Challenge #3

Imagine someone is visiting your country and write directions for two of your human features and two of your physical features. This should include compass points and road names, eg: "to find the snowy mountains, go north from the village towards Farm Street."


Science

Challenge #1

Create a fact file about all of the planets in our solar system. This should include all of the features we have discussed in English, such as headings and sub-headings. Add pictures too.

Challenge #2

Using the diagram to the right as a guide, draw the orbits of the Earth, Sun and Moon. Label them and include how long each orbit takes. You could also include the orbits of the moons of other planets and how long these take (if they have any!)



Maths

Literacy

Challenge #1

Create a visitor's guide for your made-up town. Include all of the main attractions (physical and man-made) and give directions. Make sure you add lots of pictures and colour and remember to include headings and sub-headings, like we've been talking about in literacy.

Challenge #2

Create an information text on a strange and scary creature that is thought to live somewhere in your town. You should include sub-headings. You might want to talk about what it eats, where it lives, how long it lives, and any interesting facts. Include pictures.

Challenge #3

Imagine you are out in your town one day and you stumble across your strange creature's lair. How and where do you find it? What sorts of things do you see inside? Do you manage to get back out... or does the creature catch you? Maybe it's actually friendly! Remember to use lots of expanded noun phrases and similes.
